Parlak will remain in jail

Berrien County, MI - The Berrien County man being held by the Department of Homeland Security will remain in jail for two more months.

Ibrahim Parlak was scheduled to have a second hearing Tuesday in Detroit's immigration court but that hearing has been postponed.

Parlak's defense team needed more time to prepare his case, so he won't be back in court until October 26.

Parlak, who's a Kurdish native of Turkey, is accused of being a threat to national security.

The case hinges on a Turkish conviction from the late 1980's, when Parlak was associated with what's now a terrorist group there.

Parlak could face deportation from the U.S.
